He has served as Supervising Judge at the Central Justice Center in Santa Ana, as well as the West Justice Center in Westminster, and as Supervising Judge for the Domestic Violence Courts. He also served as the Chair of the Family Violence Coordination Committee. Before his appointment to the bench, he served as an Orange County Superior Court Commissioner from 1997 to 2005.

Judge Larsh graduated from Western State University of Law with a Juris Doctor degree in 1986 and from the California State University, Fullerton, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology in 1983. He received the American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers, Southern California Section Judge of the Year Award (2016) and the Orange County Bar Association, Family Law Section J.E.T. Rutter Award for Outstanding Judicial Contribution to Family Law (2017).
