Assistant Presiding Judge Maria Hernandez' program on Human Trafficking was presented at the June 2nd luncheon at the Elks Lodge, Santa Ana.

One startling fact about Human Trafficking is that Orange County has been a "destination" county with traffickers bringing young girls into our county as sex workers. Another is that human trafficking worldwide is a \$150 Billion dollar business, and is the fastest growing crime in Orange County, second only to illicit drugs.

Girls, as young as 12-14 do not choose to be sex workers. Judge Hernandez brought a book, *Pimpology* that is a playbook on how to recruit young girls through social media, and the internet, as well as the more typical of threat and coercion. A high percentage of victims come from families where abuse and neglect have put them into the foster care system/juvenile justice court. Many are runaways who are picked up from the streets by traffickers. It's survival. Young girls meeting their quota of 8-10 encounters a day is not uncommon.
